#### **Deposits and refunds**

We will be able to finalise the leaver's account once any money is received and accounted for from HRMC, if it results in any overpayment, we will refund this together with the deposit. This generally happen by end of September. By the middle of October, all the leavers would have got their final statements with refunds, if any. #### **Child Absences**

If your child is going to be absent for any reason, kindly email the nursery before 8.30am so we can plan staffing and activities accordingly. For planned absences, please let us know in advance.

#### Children's lateness

It's vital that children are dropped to the nursery on time (ideally before 9:00am) and picked up after 4:30pm. The lateness disrupts children's learning and interrupts staff's teaching. Children who arrive later will miss out on their breakfast and key morning routines. We will not be able to accommodate breakfast thereafter as the staff will be teaching and the kitchen staff will be preparing for lunch.

#### Government funding and grants

For the parents who are new, please note that we cannot give a breakdown of the funding we receive from the council as they do not provide any details of funding on individual children. We only get a total figure per child which is distributed over the term. Our finance team, through years of experience deal with this internally and all the funding is allocated to all the children based on 15/30 hours. All the children receive the full funding as issued by the council.

Parents are responsible for completing all the sections of the funding form accurately and submitting to the nursery on time.

The first three days whilst the children are settling are not charged. Thereafter, the charges are applicable on a monthly basis or daily basis, maximum being the monthly charge.

We have attached the next year dates for the events and the new 4 weekly rolling menu.

We are able to provide exception for children with medical needs and food allergies allergens only. Any changes to the menu will reflect on the Ey app.
